

# EXPERT UN VOLUNTEER CONDITIONS OF SERVICE



## Eligibility

Age	+35 years
Education	Master's degree or higher attained
Experience	15 years



## Living Provisions

Monthly Living Allowance (MLA)	\$1682 x UN Post Adjustment + 40% Expertise Differential
Settling-In-Grant (SIG)	2 Monthly Living Allowance
Accommodation Supplement	Considered when rent exceeds 33% of MLA
Transportation/Commuting	Covered in the VLA

## Pre-Departure Facilitation



Pre-departure expenses	\$600
Shipment of personal Effects	\$500
Travel to the duty station	120% of a DLC fare
Insurance of personal effects	\$95.00 monetized Responsibility of UN Volunteer



## Dependents Policy

Travel coverage	Up to 3 dependents provided travel (under 21)
Pre-departure expenses	\$250 (1 dependent)/\$450 (2+)
Medical coverage	UNV provides up to 3 dependents at the Duty Station
Additional Settling-in-Grant (SIG)	Additional 33% of SIG for one or more eligible dependents

## Professional & Career Training Benefits



Induction Training	e-Campus and mandatory trainings
Learning and Training Allowance	\$500 per 12 month period
In-Service Training	Provided by Host Entity



## Leave Entitlements

Annual leave	30 days per year (2.5/month)
Sick leave	7 days uncertified 30 days certified
Family leave	For urgent and unforeseen circumstances
Parental leave	Contracts of +3 months: Paternity=10 days Maternity=16 weeks

## Health, Safety and Security



Well-Being Differential	Differential A \$500 a month Differential B \$1000 a month
Medical and other insurance	Medical, life, disability, dismemberment, malicious acts provided
Security	100% reimbursement per rules with UNDSS
Rest & Recuperation	Dependent on Host Entity



## Post Service Benefits

Resettlement allowance (RSA)	\$200 per month of satisfactory service
Medical benefits	1 month coverage after assignment
Travel benefits	Repatriation entitlements are provided after completion of check-out formalities
